The Biblical Model for Parenting - Deuteronomy 6:4-9

- (Sinai Method) the bulletproof plan for raising children
 - Step 1: (Hear) the Word (v.4)
 - Step 2: (Obey) the Word (v.5)
 - Step 3: (Hide) the Word in our (hearts) (v.6)
 - Step 4: (Teach) the Word to our children (v.7-9)
- <u>(Result)</u> of Parenting from the Sinai Method
 - Generation of <u>(Judges)</u>
 - Judges 2:11-17
 - Generation of (Pharisees)
 - John 5:39
- (Problem) with Parenting from the Sinai Method
 - It will not produce <u>("good")</u> children
 - Keeping the Law does not make us right before God
- (Temptations) of Parenting with the Sinai Method
 - Expecting our children to follow Biblical (imperatives) without the (Spirit).
 - Galatians 5:22-24
 - Applying the Law with the unbiblical expectation of producing something other than <u>(Judges or Pharisees)</u>.
- (<u>Solution</u>) to the Problem
 - We parent with the Law and the Gospel in <u>(unison)</u>.
- Application Points
 - In exposing our kid's sin, we don't (excuse) it.
 - We must be <u>(vulnerable)</u> and <u>(transparent)</u>.
 - Confess you sins before God especially in our parenting.
 - We have to <u>(trust)</u> God's Word.
