What it Takes to Draw Near to God

Leviticus 21

Read Leviticus 2I:I-24

Hebrews 4:16, "Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need."

Hebrews 7:25, "**25** Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them."

Hebrews 10:19-21, "**19** Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, **20** by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, **21** and having a High Priest over the house of God, **22** let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith..."

Big Idea: No One Can Draw Near to God Without Perfection in Holiness

Introduction: The Context of Leviticus 21

Problem #1: A Holy God Dwelling in the Midst of an Unholy People

Solution #1: The Lord Established the Sacrificial System to Atone for their Sins.

Problem #2 Where was God Going to Find Perfectly Holy People to Serve as Priests?

Solution #2: The Lord Established a Ritual System that Symbolized Perfection in Holiness

Main Body: Three Guidelines for the Priesthood:

1.) Limit <u>Funerals</u>

A.) Dead Bodies <u>Defile</u> and <u>Defiled</u> Priests Can't Draw Near

Numbers 19:11, "*He who touches the dead body of anyone shall be unclean seven days*."

B.) Pagan Practices Pollute and Polluted Priests Can't Draw Near

C.) Why Did All This Matter? Because Atonement Matters

2.) Forbid <u>Marriages</u>

A.) Sexual Immorality <u>Soils</u>, and <u>Soiled</u> Priests Can't Draw Near

B.) Divorce <u>Desecrates</u> and <u>Desecrated</u> Priests Can't Draw Near

C.) What Does This Have to Do With Us? Perfection in Holiness is <u>Still</u> <u>Necessary</u> to Draw Near

3.) Exclude Imperfections

A.) Priests Must be Physically Whole and <u>Complete</u> to Draw Near. They Must Be <u>Free</u> From All Physical Limitations and Deformities.

Verse 18, "For any man who has a defect shall not approach..."

Verse 23, "only he shall not go near the veil or approach the altar..."

Read verse 22
